

Year 10 Internal Examinations (Wed 18 June –Tues 24 June)

External invigilators will supervise the examinations in the Halls.

During the examination period all year 10 pupils will register in their form rooms and then make their way down to the appropriate examination halls at the beginning of period 1. Afternoon registration will be carried out in the exam halls.

Pupils will be out of lessons **ONLY** if they have examinations/practical assessments. The examinations will start at 9.25am in the morning session and 1.35pm in the afternoon session, pupils will return to normal lessons once they have completed their examination.
