What do we do?

We meet twice a term, holding information or social events.

Regularly, there's a chance to meet senior staff, learn the latest news, give your opinions and ask questions about school life and how it affects your child.

We can lobby School or the authorities if there are issues of concern to parents. We can be a collective voice for parents.

We support School activities in practical ways, for example, providing refreshments during Parents' Evenings and Open Evenings.

We raise some extra money for School through events and our 50:50 Millennium Club. £1 per week from each member provides regular income for the PFA and 50% is paid out on prizes each term.

How has money been used?

PFA pays for the commendation reward scheme. Pupils use their commendation money towards the cost of summer term activities days.

We have also contributed towards extra equipment for the Library, helped with costs for the Chess Club, Duke of Edinburgh Award programme, Geology materials and made a grant to the School Council.

PFA pays a cash grant to all students who represent Wales in sport, music or other fields.

We intend to contribute to the cost of outside benches and planting and art work by pupils inside the School.
