### Itinerary

#### Thursday 6th March

7.00pm All pupils to arrive at school

19.15pm Departure from School

23.40pm Check in at DFDS Ferry Terminal, Dover.

#### Friday 7th March

2.40am Check in at DFDS Ferry Terminal, Dover. (Meal vouchers will be provided for all party members at check-in).

- 4.40am Ferry leaves Dover for the 1 hour 30 minute crossing to Calais.
- 7.10am(French time) Ferry lands in Calais for port clearance.

We will then drive towards Disneyland Paris where pupils will have access to both the Park and Studios.

The park is open until 9.00pm. We will return to the hotel by coach.



## Saturday 8th March

After breakfast at the hotel we will leave the hotel by coach to Disneyland Paris. The park opens at 9.30am.

There will be a designated meeting point set as soon as we arrive. All pupils will be expected to return at the set times during the day and will be accompanied to the Welsh Festival events as they occur throughout the day.

Return to hotel after the Fireworks Display "Disney Dreams" which will have a Welsh themed section in honour of St. David's Day. This show starts at 9.30pm. We will return to the hotel by coach.



## Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> March

7.00am Early breakfast at the hotel.
8.00am Depart the hotel and drive towards central Paris to see the Eiffel Tower.

15.15pm Check in at DFDS Ferry Terminal, Calais.

(Meal vouchers will be provided for all party members at check in).

16.35pm Ferry leaves Calais for the 1 hour 30 minute crossing to Dover.

17.05pm (British time) Ferry lands in Dover for port clearance and return journey home.

23.59pm Estimated return time at QEH.

## What to wear for the journey?

Pupils need to ensure that they are wearing comfortable clothing. The clothes they wear to depart will be the clothes they wear to the park on Friday. (Comfortable shoes and a waterproof/warm coat is essential).



- Whilst on the coach seatbelts must be worn at all times.
- Once we board the ferry there will be a designated meeting area.
- On the ferry NO PUPILS are to go on the deck without a member of staff.
- Whilst on the ferry, pupils may use sterling or euros.
- Pupils must meet their group leader before making their way back to the coach.





Any medication needs to be handed in to the group leader prior to departure.

Medication needs to be placed in a clear bag and labelled with the pupil name and dosage instructions.



## Whilst at the park....

- Check in times will be set each day. Pupils must make their way back to the meeting point for check in.
- Pupils must stay in groups of at least 3.
- Fully qualified medical staff are permanently on site.





Disneyland has updated the process it uses to issue Priority Passes to those guests with certain medical conditions who may benefit from priority access arrangements to the attractions.

If you think your child is eligible for a priority pass, they will need to present a medical certificate, signed and dated within the last 3 months, stating that they are suffering from a medical condition.



## Other important information:-

• Tickets – Tickets have been upgraded to Hooper Passes at no additional cost. (This means access to the park and studios on both days). Tickets need to be kept safe during the day. They will be handed out by member of staff on Friday morning and collected Friday evening. These are our entry tickets for Saturday therefore they need to be kept safe. Any lost tickets will need to be paid for. These cost over €100.
