

Module 1 - Me presento (Here I am)

Pupils will learn how to introduce themselves and give basic details about themselves. They will also learn the colours and the words for items used in the classroom.

Pupils will also be expected to become more self-reliant with a greater emphasis on the use of dictionary skills and adapting language to meet their needs. In year 10, pupils can opt to study French and/or Spanish GCSE which will ultimately lead on to A/AS level in either language.
