This Portfolio of work has been ongoing since Year 10, and pupils have had ample time and support to accumulate sufficient work to satisfy the assessment objectives at a consistent level.

The second unit of work, the exam unit, has been removed, in order to allow all candidates extra time to concentrate on their Portfolios.
