










What options Do I Have?

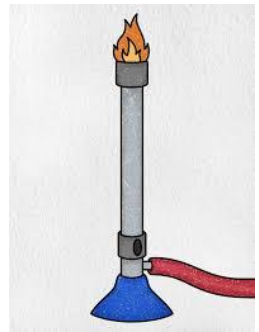

What about Science ?

- ▶ Everyone has to follow a course in science
- ▶ Most follow a science course that leads to **TWO** GCSEs. This is perfectly adequate to go on and study A Level
- ▶ Some pupils will be able to follow a **TRIPLE** award science course, with separate Biology, Chemistry and Physics.
- ▶ This will count as one of your three option choices

What are Vocational Courses?

- ▶ An alternative to GCSE
 - ▶ Courses related to a job or type of employment
 - ▶ Learn the basic knowledge and skills for the job
 - ▶ NVQ and BTEC
 - ▶ Assessment is ongoing with fewer exams
 - ▶ Taught and awarded at Level 1 (Grade D to G) and level 2 (Grade A*–C)
 - ▶ Some are worth more than 1 GCSE

- ▶ Engineering (Level 2)
- ▶ Tourism (Level 1 / 2)
- ▶ BTEC Preparation for Public Services
- ▶ Hair & Beauty (VTCT Level 2)
- ▶ NVQ Vehicle Component Fitting (Level 2)
- ▶ IT User Skills in Open Systems & Enterprise (Level 2 Certificate)
- ▶ BTEC Business
- ▶ BTEC IT (Information & Creative Technology)
- ▶ BTEC Personal Growth & Wellbeing (Level 2)

Why These Choices Matter

Your options can:

- Help you **enjoy school more**
- Build confidence in what you're good at
- Prepare you for **post-16 choices**
- Show future colleges/employers your strengths



How to Choose Well

Ask yourself:

- ✓ Do I **enjoy** this subject?
- ✓ Am I **good** at it or improving?
- ✓ Am I willing to **work hard** at it?
- ✓ Does it balance my other choices?

💡 The best choice = **interest + effort**

What NOT to Base Choices On

⊘ Choosing just because:

- Your friends picked it
- You think it's "easy"
- You like/dislike a teacher
- Someone else chose it for you




☞ This is **your future**, not anyone else's.

You Don't Need All the Answers Yet

Important to know:

- Most jobs do not require specific GCSE options
- English, Maths & Science matter most overall
- You can change direction later
- Success comes from **doing well**, not just what you choose

What Changes at Key Stage 4?

- Fewer subjects
 - A chance to choose some aspects of your curriculum
 - Thinking about the future
 - Seeking (and accepting) advice

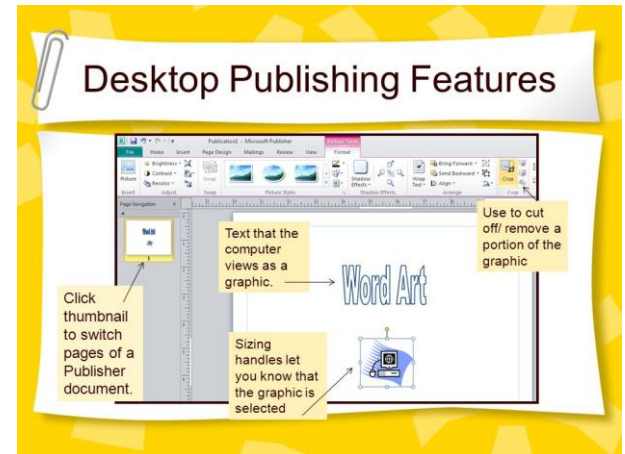

Important Points to note

- ▶ Not all subjects will run – dependent on numbers
- ▶ Some subjects limited by numbers (some practical subjects prioritised to good attendees)
- ▶ Some subjects will be prioritised to global grades
- ▶ Option block clashes will make some combinations impossible – you must **PRIORITISE!**
- ▶ Reserve choices are important

⚠️ Some subjects depend on numbers, so flexibility matters.




