Course Outline

The course consists of seven units and no formal examination. This qualification is equivalent to 1 A Level.

Three of the units are compulsory and 4 units will be chosen by the subject teacher.

The three compulsory units are:-

- · The hospitality industry
- Principles of supervising customer service performance in Hospitality, Leisure, Travel and Tourism
- Providing customer service in Hospitality.

The candidate will be awarded one of the following results on completion of the 2 years Pass (E) Merit (C) Distinction (A).
