#### **Course Outline & Assessment**

There are 4 units which are completed over the two year course, with some units externally assessed:

- 1. Anatomy and Physiology (mandatory unit) External exam 1.5 hours
- 2. Fitness Training and Programming for Health, Sport and Well-Being (mandatory unit) <u>Externally Controlled Assessment</u>
- 3. Professional Development in the Sports Industry (mandatory unit) <u>Internally assessed</u> <u>unit</u>
- 4. The final unit will be selected from the following units:

- Application of Fitness Testing
- Sports Psychology
- Practical Sports Performance
