BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in ICT is a two year qualification equivalent to one A Level.

Designed to support pupils who have an interest in the computer sector through the variety of tasks.

Pupils will study 4 units

- 3 are mandatory (2 externally assessed)
- 1 optional
- 33% external written examination

Course Outline

Learners must complete:

- 3 mandatory units
- (At least) 1 optional unit

Mandatory Units

- 1. Information Technology Systems
- 2. Creating Systems to Manage Information
- 3. Using Social Media in Business

Optional Units

- 1. Data Modelling
- 2. Website Development
